

#### Property Management occupancy 2021




### Property Management occupancy 2021, 2020 and 2019








### The pandemic

## Pandox's business model has passed the test

- Weak and volatile demand due to (on/off) restrictions
- > Our focus has been on maintaining financial flexibility
- > Positive cash earnings every quarter thanks to minimum and fixed rent
- Investments of approximately MSEK 2,000 in existing portfolio
- Acquisition of extended stay in Edinburgh for MGBP 40.5
- > Main exposure towards domestic demand which is driving the recovery
